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Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Reception. We are really looking forward to welcoming you all. We have an amazing year ahead, packed with lots of exciting learning. Below is information on all of the learning and topics that will be covered in the Autumn term.

Communication, Language and Literacy:

To develop communication, language and literacy we will be using the following texts:

Brown Bear, Brown Bear what do you see?

Kippers birthday

I'm too small for school.

Colour monster

The family book

Elmer

The main focus for writing will be practising name writing and labelling work using initial sounds. For phonics, the children will be starting Phase 2, starting with S, A, T, P, I, N.

Mathematics

Order two or three items by length or height

Count up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.

Count actions or objects which cannot be moved.

Count objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.

Count out up to six objects from a larger group.

Select the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects.

Count an irregular arrangement of up to ten objects.

Physical Development

Each day the children will be participating in Busy Finger activities to develop their fine motor skills.

In PE we will develop listening to instructions, finding a space and using the body to move in different ways.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In PSHE we will be looking at the following themes:

How Am I feeling Today?

Being at School

Gentle Hands

Expressive Arts and Design

Our role play areas for this term is 'Home Corner'.

For music, the focus will be singing, rhythm games, hand percussion and to copy back singing and rhythm patterns

For art and design, the children will use a variety of media and techniques to explore colours and colour mixing.

PE- Thursday morning. Children will get changed in school. They need separate trainers and PE kit.

Reading records and reading books in school every day.

All clothing/belongings to be labelled with names.

Children to read and get reading records signed by an adult to earn reading reward books!
