Assembly Theme and value: Attitude, Hope and Joy

We have used the NSPCC resources around Speak Out, Stay Safe in assembly to help us understand how to say when something is not right when it comes to personal safety. We then moved on to the British Value of Individual Liberty, learning about the choices we can make in Britain and how we can express ourselves while being respectful to others. We have also thought about hope and how it can keep us going through challenging times we face. We have celebrated children who recognise the importance of Individual Liberty and those who use hope positively when facing challenges.
